Overview



Tarangire National Park

At 0600 hrs, you will be conveniently picked up from your hotel in either Moshi or Arusha and transported to the breathtaking Tarangire National Park for your safari adventure. Spanning a vast area of 1,600 square miles, Tarangire National Park proudly holds the title as the fifth largest park in Tanzania. The park derives its name from the Tarangire River, a life-giving force that sustains wildlife in the region with its permanent water source. During the dry season, this remarkable river becomes a focal point as it attracts an incredible gathering of elephants, buffalos, wildebeests, and zebras along its banks. Tarangire's most significant feature is its role as a haven for the largest elephant population in northern Tanzania. Following your immersive tour of the park, you will be comfortably transported back to either Moshi or Arusha in the afternoon.

Important Notes

The weather conditions are known to vary while on Safari. Mornings and evenings are generally cooler, but it can get very hot during the day. You should expect hot, dry afternoons while on safari. Roads in the National Parks are all dirt/gravel roads and tend to be dusty during the dry season and muddy during the wet season.

For a comfortable trip, we recommend you bring:

- Light clothing
- Sunhats
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Warm clothing like a sweater or jacket

Vehicles & Driver Guides

Wild animal attacks are extremely rare and we have never had such an incident but it is always important to remember that you will be traveling through the wilderness and it is of utmost importance to abide by the rules and regulations of the parks and accommodation facilities you will be staying in so as to ensure your safety. Always listen to your driver-guides' advice and instructions as far as wild animals are concerned. While traveling with small children please make sure you do not let them out of your sight or wander alone. In some private tented camps it is important to have an escort with you when moving in and out of your tent at night.

Dietary Restrictions

We cater to a wide range of dietary requirements while on safari therefore it should not be a concern at all.

Shopping for Souvenirs

There will be plenty of opportunities to buy souvenirs while on safari. There are many Curio Shops along the way to the major parks where you can get a wide range of items ranging from wooden carvings, local paintings, jewelry, local arts & crafts to gemstones such as Tanzanite.

Wild Animals & Safety

During your safari adventure, you will have the pleasure of being accompanied by our skilled and knowledgeable driver-guides who possess a deep understanding of wildlife and tour guiding. In the rugged terrain of the parks, flat tires occasionally occur during game drives. However, our driver-guides efficiently handle tire changes without causing significant disruption to your safari experience.

Rest assured, vehicle breakdowns are extremely rare as our vehicles undergo rigorous maintenance measures. In the unlikely event of a breakdown, we have a prompt solution in place. We would immediately dispatch a replacement vehicle to your location, ensuring that your safari continues seamlessly as planned.
