Llanos del Cortes Waterfalls

The Llanos del Cortes Waterfall is located near the town of Bagaces, just a half hour south of Liberia. It's a short drive off the Pan American Highway (Route 1) and less than a two-hour trip from Tamarindo. The falls are wide and wispy, with thin streams of water tumbling along the mossy rocks. Rocky cliffs are visible through the transparent cascade. To add to the grandeur, thick forest surrounds the falls with many birds and sometimes even monkeys bellowing from the trees.
