Lima - Cusco

Arrive in Cusco and get ready to explore!

In the afternoon we will be visiting the four archaeological complexes on the outskirts of Cusco on horseback. This fabulous half-day tour will take passengers through the most important places in Cusco with a guide providing explanations in each of the places we visit, which are: Tambomachay, Puka Pukara, Qenqo, Saqsayhuaman, all while traveling through the magnificent landscape of the Andes.

Sacred Valley Full Day Tour

Today you will have a guided tour along the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Start the day with an immersive experience visiting Chinchero town and market. Then you will visit the iconic Incan sites of the Maras salt pans and the Moray ringed terraces.

Then head to the ancient fortress of Ollantaytambo ruins where you can take a short but steep hike to the terraces and learn about the genius of Incan architecture as well as take pictures of the valley below.

After the tour, we will head to the train station of Ollantaytambo to start our Machu Picchu adventure.

After a 1.5 hour train journey through jagged mountains and cloud forests, you'll disembark at the charming village of Aguas Calientes, then you will head to your Machu Picchu hotel.

Note: To prepare for the next day, please pack an overnight bag with enough clothes and toiletries for 1

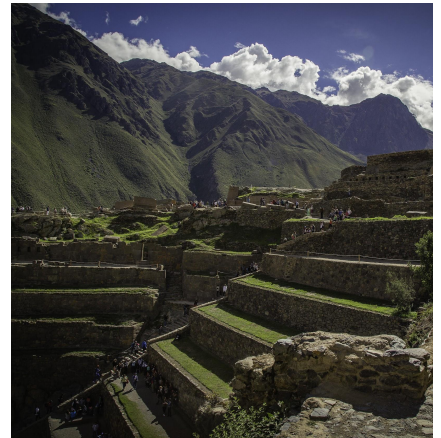


days and 1 night. The rest of your luggage will be stored at the hotel in Cusco.

Machu Picchu - Cusco

Please bear in mind that a copy of your passport is required for the purchase of Machu Picchu tickets. Availability is limited and tickets can only be guaranteed once issued.

Wake up early to catch the best views of the famed Inca fortress of Machu Picchu, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that has been astonishing travelers for years.

After breakfast, we will head to the bus stop to take a 30-minute bus ride to the Machu Picchu archaeological site.

One of the "New Seven Wonders of the World," Machu Picchu is a spectacular and mysterious citadel that dates back to approximately 1450. Your historian guide will lead you on a tour of the ruins, visiting the temples, terraces, and all the best spots for photos. After a day of exploring, the group will return to Cusco in the evening.

Lunch and dinner are not included today.

Rainbow Mountain

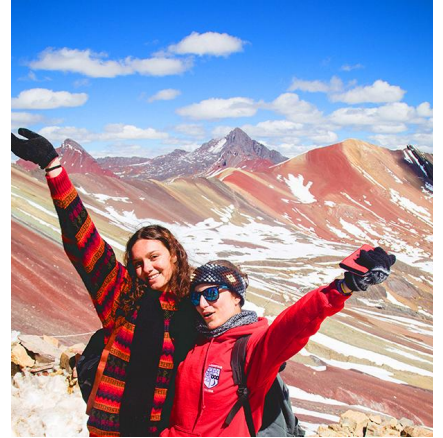
Rainbow Mountain

Rainbow Mountain is a natural wonder painted with sedimentary layers of red, blue, and gold. After a 3.5-hour bus trip, you'll set out on a high-altitude hike through small communities, herds of alpacas and llamas, and landscapes with views of the sacred Ausangate Mountain. Breakfast and lunch will be provided. When you arrive to your destination, take photos and enjoy the views before returning to Cusco.

Important Notes

In an effort to protect this epic site and the natural beauty that surrounds it, the local authorities have introduced the following rules & regulations:

- The Machu Picchu regulations state that reservations will only be guaranteed when the following passenger information is provided:
 - Full name
 - Nationality



- Passport number
- Date of birth
- Gender

Once you have completed the payment for the Machu Picchu experience, please be aware that:

- Tickets are non refundable, nor endorsable
- No changes of date are allowed
- After entering the Machu Picchu site, you cannot exit and re-enter
- Visits to Machu Picchu are subject to a 4 hour time limit (average tour duration is 2.5 hours)
- The pedestrian traffic within the site is one-way only

Machu Picchu has a maximum capacity of visitors per day therefore we highly recommend you reserve your tickets as far in advance as possible.

Passport information provided must be precise: In case of any discrepancies the government reserves the right to deny entrance to any person whose information does not line up exactly with the ticket issued.

Other important details:

- The average temperature at Machu Picchu is 18° C / 64° F
- There are no toilet facilities inside the Machu Picchu site
- Depending on the train schedule, you may need to return to Aguas Calientes around 2:00pm
- Train schedules are subject to change throughout the year

Please note this itinerary is subject to change according to COVID regulations

For a comfortable trip, we recommend you bring:

- Layers of clothing (t-shirt, long sleeves, sweater, jacket)
- Rain protection (for the afternoons)
- Hat or cap
- Good walking shoes (no sandals)
- Sunscreen (at least SPF 30), even if it is overcast
- Small lunch and snacks
- Camera
- Face mask
