Overview

Discover the natural beauty of Costa Rica's Guanacaste province on this four-day journey, starting in Tamarindo and continuing on to Liberia. Cool off at the wide, refreshing cascade of Llanos de Cortés, then explore the historic streets of Liberia on a guided city tour. Hike through forest and river to the striking La Leona Waterfall, and journey into Tenorio Volcano National Park to see the turquoise waters of Río Celeste. Visit a local sloth and reptile farm, and close out the trip with a relaxing morning at Poza Los Coyotes.

Highlights of the Trip

- Cool off at Llanos de Cortés, one of Costa Rica's most beautiful waterfalls
- Explore Liberia, the "White City," on a guided evening tour
- Hike to La Leona Waterfall through forest and river
- Enjoy a traditional lunch at a Guanacaste farm
- Discover the turquoise waters of Río Celeste in Tenorio Volcano National Park
- Visit a local sloth and reptile farm
- Relax and swim at Poza Los Coyotes

Sunday

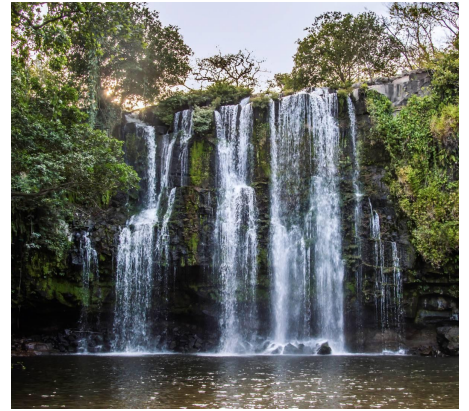
Llanos de Cortés Waterfall & Liberia City Tour

The day begins with a transfer from Tamarindo to Liberia to check in at the hotel. In the afternoon, visit Llanos de Cortés Waterfall, where you can cool off and enjoy the surroundings. Return to Liberia for a guided city tour, followed by free time for dinner.

Tuesday

Tenorio Volcano National Park & Río Celeste

Explore the stunning Tenorio Volcano National Park, home to lush rainforests and diverse wildlife such as white-faced monkeys, sloths, and exotic birds. Hike the trails to witness the source of the Río Celeste, known for its striking turquoise waters. Afterward, visit a local sloth and reptile farm for a closer look at these incredible creatures.

Poza Los Coyotes & Departure

After breakfast, visit Poza Los Coyotes to cool off and enjoy the morning. Return to Liberia, where transfer out will be coordinated according to your flight schedule.
