City Tour & Equatorial Line

Today you will visit "Quito" the most beautiful and colonial city in South America, declared by UNESCO part of the Cultural Heritage of mankind. You will explore the colonial part of the city and you will start in the Independence square, with the presidential palace, the city hall, the Sagrario church and the Cathedral.

You will then, visit La Compañía church (1605) and its breathtaking gilded altars, finest example of baroque art in America. After this, you will visit San Francisco church (1535). You will then visit the art & crafts gallery of Tianguuez and finally, drive up to the Panecillo hill and enjoy an amazing view of Quito from above, and admire the only winged-Virgin statue in South America. This is a great spot to take pictures above Quito.

After visiting the colonial center of Quito you will go to the Middle of the World, which is located 25 km north of Ecuador's capital. Here, you will visit the Intiñan museum, where is actually the latitude 0° 0' 0" and you will experience all the interesting phenomenon that happens in this unique place. After this, you will visit the Middle of the World Monument, having the opportunity to stand in both hemispheres and take wonderful pictures.

Mindo Cloud Forest

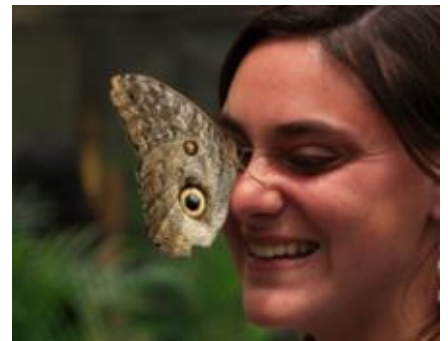
